

EXAMINATION - FAQs

1.What is the passing criteria for class IX & X?

In order to pass the CBSE Class 9 exams, students need to obtain a minimum of 33% marks in both the internal and external assessments. - This means students must score at least 6.6 marks out of 20 in the internal assessment and 26.4 marks out of 80 in the external assessment.

2.What is the passing criteria for class XI and XII?

The pass marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33%. In case of a subject involving practical work/Project/Internal examination a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% marks in practical/project/internal separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.

3.What is the minimum percentage of attendance required for appearing Class X and XII Board exam?

As per the Standard Operating Procedure, (SOPs) prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), students are required to have a minimum of **75 per cent** mandatory attendance for appearing in the class 10 and 12 board exams.
