## EXAMINATION - FAQs

## 1.What is the passing criteria for class IX \& $\mathbf{X}$ ?

In order to pass the CBSE Class 9 exams, students need to obtain a minimum of $33 \%$ marks in both the internal and external assessments. - This means students must score at least 6.6 marks out of 20 in the internal assessment and 26.4 marks out of 80 in the external assessment.

## 2.What is the passing criteria for class XI and XII?

The pass marks in each subject of external examination shall be $33 \%$. In case of a subject involving practical work/Project/Internal examination a candidate must obtain $33 \%$ marks in theory and $33 \%$ marks in practical/project/internal separately in addition to $33 \%$ marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.

## 3. What is the minimum percentage of attendance required for appearing Class X and XII Board exam?

As per the Standard Operating Procedure, (SOPs) prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), students are required to have a minimum of 75 per cent mandatory attendance for appearing in the class 10 and 12 board exams.
