ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

- ⚙ Applications will be available at the school admission cell starting from December.
- ⚙ Parents must pay the term fees on or before the specified due date.
- ⚙ Parents seeking admission must provide the Transfer Certificate (T.C.) and Progress report from their previous institution.
- ⚙ The request for a Transfer Certificate should reach the school office before the specified due date.
- ⚙ If the T.C. application is delayed, the first-term fee for the next academic year must be paid before the Transfer Certificate is issued.
- ⚙ In case of any delay in fee payment, students will not be allowed to write the term exams.
- ⚙ The specified deadlines for term fee payments are given below:

RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✿ Students should be punctual and follow the school's rules and regulations. Every student should wear their identity card and bring their school diary daily.
- ✿ Students should adhere strictly to the dress code and avoid wearing jarring accessories.
- ✿ The school uniform must be worn on all school days and during school functions.
- ✿ Boys should have a short crew haircut, and long, unkempt hair is not allowed. Girls should tie their hair neatly in a single plait using a white hair band. Short hair should be neatly tied in a ponytail, and fringes should be clipped neatly.
- ✿ Students should be punctual for the assembly. Latecomers and absentees will be allowed only with a late attendance and leave record duly signed by the parents.
- ✿ If a student is a continuous defaulter (three or more days), the parents must meet the Principal; otherwise, entry will be restricted.
- ✿ Students should strictly avoid tattoos, gold jewellery, bangles, or flowers in school. Chewing gum, drugs, and soft drinks are strictly prohibited.
- ✿ Bullying is a punishable offence and is strictly prohibited on campus and in school transport. Inappropriate language on campus or in the school bus is strictly prohibited.
- ✿ Mobile phones, electronic gadgets, toys, and magazines are strictly prohibited. Possessing them without prior permission will result in strict disciplinary action. Confiscated mobile phones cannot be claimed under any circumstances.
- ✿ Attendance will be marked twice, in the morning and the afternoon session. Leave of absence will be granted only upon submission of a leave application signed by the parents.
- ✿ For extended absences or prolonged illness, a medical certificate must be submitted with the leave application.
- ✿ Students should refrain from scribbling on walls, messing up classrooms, or damaging school property.
- ✿ Parents/guardians must compensate for any damage caused by their ward.
- ✿ Exchange of valuables or money transactions between students is not allowed.
- ✿ Students should actively participate in all sports activities, club activities, community outreach programmes, cultural programmes, and field visits. They should utilise all the opportunities provided by the school.
- ✿ Non-adherence to school rules will lead to disciplinary action.

GENERAL GUIDELINES TO THE PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- ⚙️ The school gates will open at 7:45 a.m and close at 8:45 a.m
- ⚙️ Latecomers should meet the Principal.
- ⚙️ Students with three or more absences in a month are required to meet with the Principal, accompanied by their parents or guardians.
- ⚙️ Gate Number 1 is to be used for entry in the morning, and Gate Number 2 for exit.
- ⚙️ After dropping off the children on campus, vehicles should leave the campus immediately.
- ⚙️ Teachers in charge and the admin's at the gate will take care of your wards.
- ⚙️ Any changes in the schedule will be communicated through a circular.

SAFETY & SECURITY MEASURES

- ⚙️ Parking of vehicles is not allowed inside the campus.
- ⚙️ Vehicles must be parked outside the campus during afternoon dispersal.
- ⚙️ Parents must wait near the barricade to collect their wards.
- ⚙️ Students from Classes I – VIII will be accompanied by their class teachers during dispersal.
- ⚙️ If parents of students in Grades I – VIII request to retain their wards until they arrive, they must write in and submit a requisition form at the reception.
- ⚙️ An escort pass must be carried by all parents and guardians nominated by them.
- ⚙️ Parents must maintain a safe speed while entering the campus.
- ⚙️ Parents on two-wheelers must remove their helmets and face masks before entering the campus.
- ⚙️ Entry into the school premises is not allowed without prior permission.
- ⚙️ If a parent needs to visit during school hours, a prior appointment must be booked at the reception.
- ⚙️ The gates will close promptly at 6:00 p.m.

DRESS CODE

Parents are expected to follow an appropriate dress code while entering the school campus. Inappropriate clothing is strictly forbidden.

MEN

- ⚙️ Casual clothes like lungis, Bermudas, and shorts are not permitted.
- ⚙️ Formal and appropriate attire is mandatory.

WOMEN

- ⚙️ To maintain the institution's decorum, provocative and revealing clothing should be avoided.
- ⚙️ Nightgowns and informal clothing are not permitted.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ✿ Homework and other assigned tasks must be completed regularly.
- ✿ Students who fail to complete homework will not be allowed into the classroom.
- ✿ Parents must attend the PTM, organised term-wise, to discuss their ward's progress.
- ✿ School transport can be availed. Parents must fill in the transport enquiry form.
- ✿ The nearest pick-up points will be assigned by the transport manager. Doorstep pick-up and drop-off will not be provided.
- ✿ Parents should ensure that lunch and snacks are packed properly. Healthy snacks, preferably fruits, sprouts, and peanuts, can be sent.
- ✿ Students should carry a lunch towel and a spoon.
- ✿ Packed lunch should preferably be vegetarian and appropriately portioned. Food wastage should be discouraged.
- ✿ Grievances will be addressed immediately. A requisition letter can be submitted to the student office, or messages can be sent through the "Concerns" option in the school app.
- ✿ The username and password for the school app must be kept secure.
- ✿ Students must be accompanied by their parents if they are late and must provide a valid reason for entry into the classroom during school hours.
- ✿ Active parental participation in nurturing their wards is essential, and they are expected to monitor their daily routine.
- ✿ Parents are expected to maintain decorum in the educational institution, and any violation will be dealt with strictly.
- ✿ Students are expected to handle school property with care and take responsibility for its protection. Any breakage or damage to school property must be compensated for immediately.
- ✿ Parents should encourage their wards to develop language skills, cultivate the habit of reading, and stay updated.
- ✿ Colloquial language is not encouraged on campus.
- ✿ Truancy will not be tolerated by the school authorities in the best interest of students.
- ✿ Leave will be granted only for genuine reasons and upon prior submission of a leave application for planned absences.
- ✿ In case of an emergency or unavoidable circumstances, parents must fill out the "Record of Absence" with valid reasons, without which the student will not be allowed into the classroom.
- ✿ A medical certificate must be submitted after recovery from any contagious or prolonged illness.

The prescribed quarantine periods for the following viral and bacterial infections are as follows:

- Chickenpox - Until the scabs fall off completely
 - Cholera - Until full recovery
 - Measles - Two weeks after the rashes disappear
 - Mumps - Until the swelling subsides
 - Whooping cough - Six weeks
 - Jaundice - Six weeks

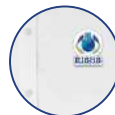
UNIFORM PATTERN FOR GRADE IV TO VIII
