ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE

- Applications will be available at the school Admission Cell starting from November. Parents seeking admission may contact the Admission Team for further details.
- Parents seeking admission must provide the Transfer Certificate (T.C.) and Progress report from their previous institution.
- The request for session-end Transfer Certificate must reach the school office before the specified due date by the school.
- If the T.C. application is delayed, the first-term fee for the next academic year must be paid before the Transfer Certificate is issued.

FEE PAYMENT

- Parents must pay the term fees on or before the specified due date. In case of any delay in fee payment, students will not be allowed to write the term exams.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- ✿ Students should be punctual and follow the school's rules and regulations. Every student must wear their identity card and bring their school diary daily.
- ✿ Students should adhere strictly to the school uniform and avoid wearing jarring accessories.
- ✿ The school uniform must be worn on all school days and also for all school events.
- ✿ Boys should have a short even haircut. Long, unkempt hair is not allowed. Girls should tie their hair neatly in a single plait using a white hair band. Short hair should be neatly tied in a ponytail, and fringes should be clipped neatly.
- ✿ Students should be punctual for the assembly. Latecomers and absentees will be allowed only with a late attendance and leave record duly signed by the parents.
- ✿ If a student is a continuous defaulter (three or more days), the parents must meet the Principal; otherwise, entry will be restricted.
- ✿ Students should strictly avoid tattoos, gold and silver jewellery, bangles, or flowers in school. Chewing gum, any unwarranted substance, and soft drinks are strictly prohibited.
- ✿ Bullying is a punishable offence and is strictly prohibited on campus and in school transport. Inappropriate language on campus or in the school bus is strictly prohibited.
- ✿ Mobile phones, electronic gadgets, toys, and magazines are strictly prohibited. Possessing them without prior permission will result in strict disciplinary action. Confiscated mobile phones cannot be claimed under any circumstances.
- ✿ Students should refrain from scribbling on walls, messing up classrooms, or damaging school property.
- ✿ Exchange of valuables or money transactions between students is not allowed inside the school premises.
- ✿ Students should actively participate in all sports activities, club activities, community outreach programmes, cultural programmes, and field visits. They should utilise all the opportunities provided by the school.
- ✿ Non-adherence to school rules will lead to disciplinary action.

GENERAL GUIDELINES TO THE PARENTS / GUARDIANS

- ✿ The school gates will open at 7:45 a.m and close at 8:45 a.m for the students of classes I to XII
- ✿ Latecomers should meet the Principal.
- ✿ Students with three or more absences in a month are required to meet with the Principal, accompanied by their parents or guardians.
- ✿ Gate Number 1 is to be used for entry in the morning, and Gate Number 2 for exit.
- ✿ After dropping off the children on campus, vehicles should leave the campus immediately. Teachers in charge and the admin's at the gate will take care of the students
- ✿ Any changes in the schedule will be communicated through a circular.

SAFETY & SECURITY MEASURES

- ✿ Parking of vehicles is not allowed inside the campus.
- ✿ Vehicles must be parked outside the campus during afternoon dispersal.
- ✿ Parents must wait near the barricade to collect their wards.
- ✿ Students from Classes I – VIII will be accompanied by their class teachers during dispersal.
- ✿ If parents of students in Grades I – VIII request to retain their wards until they arrive, they must write in and submit a requisition form at the reception.
- ✿ An escort pass must be carried by all parents and guardians nominated by them.
- ✿ Parents must maintain a safe speed while entering the campus.
- ✿ Parents on two-wheelers must remove their helmets and face masks before entering the campus.
- ✿ Entry into the school premises is not allowed without prior permission.
- ✿ If a parent needs to meet the principal during school hours, a prior appointment must be booked at the reception.
- ✿ The gates will close promptly at 6:00 p.m.

DRESS CODE

Parents are expected to follow an appropriate dress code while entering the school campus. Inappropriate clothing is strictly forbidden.

MEN

- ✿ Casual clothes like lungis, Bermudas, and shorts are not permitted.
- ✿ Formal and appropriate attire is mandatory.

WOMEN

- ✿ To maintain the institution's decorum, provocative and revealing clothing should be avoided.
- ✿ Nightgowns and informal clothing are not permitted.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- ✿ Homework and other assigned tasks must be completed regularly.
- ✿ Students who fail to complete homework will not be allowed into the classroom.
- ✿ Parents must attend the PTM, organised by the school, to discuss their ward's academic progress.
- ✿ Parents who wish to avail the school transport service must contact the school office.
- ✿ The nearest pick-up points will be assigned by the transport manager. Doorstep pick-up and drop-off will not be provided.
- ✿ Parents should ensure that your child brings properly packed lunch and healthy snacks to school. Fruits, sprouts, and peanuts are recommended. Please avoid sending junk food.
- ✿ Students should carry a lunch towel and a spoon.
- ✿ Packed lunch should preferably be vegetarian and appropriately portioned. Food wastage should be discouraged.
- ✿ Grievances will be addressed immediately. A requisition letter can be submitted to the school office.
- ✿ Active parental participation in nurturing your child is essential. Parents are requested to regularly monitor their child's daily work and progress.
- ✿ Parents are requested to check their ward's almanac regularly and stay updated on school communications, assignments, and instructions.
- ✿ Parents are expected to maintain decorum in the educational institution, and any violation will be dealt with strictly.
- ✿ Students are expected to handle school property with care and take responsibility for its protection. Any breakage or damage to school property must be compensated for immediately.
- ✿ Parents should encourage their wards to develop language skills, cultivate the habit of reading, and stay updated.
- ✿ Colloquial language is not encouraged on campus.
- ✿ Truancy will not be tolerated by the school authorities in the best interest of students.
- ✿ Leave will be granted only for genuine reasons and upon prior submission of a leave application for planned absences.
- ✿ In case of an emergency or unavoidable circumstances, parents must fill out the "Record of Absence" with valid reasons, without which the student will not be allowed into the classroom.
- ✿ A medical certificate must be submitted after recovery from any contagious or prolonged illness.
